

1052025 Instructions:

NOTE: DO NOT TIGHTEN ANY CLAMPS UNTIL THE LAST STEP!!

- 1) Support the vehicle in a safe manner, using a shop hoist or frame contact jack stands on a level surface. Remove the old exhaust system at the rear muffler. Cut 3" from the welds on the back side of the o.e. dual in/dual out resonator just before the rear wheels. You would be leaving 3" stubs after the welds. Remove the rear O.E. muffler.
- 2) You will have to remove the right and left OEM rear tailpipe hanger mounts from the car to remove and install the new tailpipes. There are two nuts on each hanger mount, use a 15mm wrench. Pay careful attention to how they came off, you will be re-using these.
- 3) Install the left (driver side) and right (passenger side) tail pipe with tips to the O.E. exhaust stubs left from your cuts you made in step 1). Use the 2-1/4" accused clamps to connect.
- 4) Insert the wire rods on the tailpipes into the factor rubber mounts on car.
- 5) Re-install the O.E. rear hanger mounts removed in step 2). Slide the rear hanger rods into the mounts first, then put them up on the studs and re-tighten using the nuts removed earlier.
- 6) Check for clearance of the frame, body, suspension members, and of all brake and fuel lines. When you are satisfied with how the system hangs, tighten all clamps.
